SYSTEMATIC REVIEW AND META-ANALYSIS

A one-day workshop and hands-on training was organized by Department of Pharmacy Practice Nirmala College of Pharmacy, Muvattupuzha Ernakulam district, Kerala In Collaboration With ISPOR, KUHS, Student Chapter on 23 May 2021 at 10:00 AM through Online mode. The Resource Person of the day was Mr. Muhammed Rashid, DST INSPIRE Fellow, Research Scholar, MCOPS, MAHE. About 101 delegates Registered and 99 attended the same .

Summary of the program: The webinar was designed to develop the knowledge of Systematic review and meta-analysis concepts among the students and faculties to promote college research. The hands-on training was provided on literature search in various databases and data extraction process with Risk of bias assessment. The workshop further involved the analysis of various data using the RevMan software program.



HPTLC:TECHNIQUE AND PHARMA APPLICATION

In “Nirmala College of Pharmacy, Department of Pharmacognosy organised a webinar entitled “ HPTLC:Technique and Pharma Application ”. The main aim of the seminar is to create awareness on HPTLC and its applications among the students and faculty in the field of Pharmacy. The webinar commenced at 10.30 am on Thursday 27th May 2020 with welcome by Dr. Prasanth ,Associate Professor, Department of Pharmacognosy. It was followed by the session on HPTLC and finally concluded by question and answer section followed by vote of thanks.

The session was handled by Sneha Singh, Instrumentation Chemist, Anchrom. The session starts with small introduction to Anchrom and their activities, Evolution of High Performance Thin layer chromatography from TLC (instrumental T L C, software-controlled TLC, HPTLC and finally to Robotic HPTLC), a comparison between TLC (simplicity, low cost, rapid, preliminary results, low cost etc) and HPTLC (reproducibility, reliable analytical results, simple, fast, safe etc.) and so on.

This was followed by a detailed section on HPTLC its **Principle, Method** In this she covered various sections like Sample preparation (100 mg in 1 ml Methanol, sonicate for 15 minutes, centrifuge at 5000 rpm, use supernatant), Sample applicators (Robotic applicator, Autosampler, Linomat etc.), Sample application techniques (quantitative, in situ clean up, micro prep. Isolation, superimpose), Band application (separation power high, application of more samples, resolution high, less solvent ie. 20ml for 15 samples, less time ie. 50-60 sec), Mobile phase (Freshly prepared mobile phase, 20 min chamber saturation) and Stationary phase selection in HPTLC (Silica gel 60 F254 or RP-18), Chromatogram isocratic development using twin through chamber (based on size of plates, disadvantage: difficult to control humidity), auto develop chamber, gradient elution chamber, robotic development module (fully automatic, humidity control, auto monitoring of solvent front) etc. , Image documentation using Visualizer (Finger printing- image of visual chromatogram based on R_f value), Densitometric scanning, Derivatization (using spray reagent and plate heater), Image documentation and scanning , Regulatory acceptance for HPTLC (developing distance, suitable band length, distance to solvent level, relative humidity) , Essential requirements for quality control , Advantage (At a time 6 analyst can simultaneously work at one set of device, Database oriented software, Minimal use of solvents), Applications (comparison of multiple samples , Screening of Unknown Plant Extracts , Quantitative evaluation like quantification of API in various formulations, Spectra comparison, Screening of toxicity and adulterants, profiling of water) etc.





She explained various research works using HPTLC and displayed various referencebooks which help the researches working on HPTLC.

The webinar was attended by students and faculties of our college. Over 80 people registered and around **70** people joined online. The session was coordinated by Dr. Bharat Mishra, Head, R&D cell, Dept. of Pharmacology and moderated by Mr. Dhanish Joseph, Head, Dept. of Pharmaceutics and he provided a brief overview about the speaker and session. He introduced Dr. Muralidhara Anandamurthy (Member, JMP global academic) and invited for deliberation. JMP is a statistical discovery tool (software) from SAS for Researchers and scientists. JMP is used across industries. He introduced this software which is specific to pharma, many companies Ipsen, Ono Pharma, Medytox, Menarini, ACI, AstraZeneca, NNE, Janssen, Tillotts, London DNA foundry, etc His talk inspired all pharma graduates for using this software. JMP is part of most Universities across globe (use for teaching and Research). R& D CELL He also added the benefits of JMP which includes, Designing of experiments, Data visualization and Exploratory Data analysis, Statistics, predictive modelling and machine learning etc. The presentations and Q&A were followed by a brief panel discussion with the presenters. After a long and lengthy discussion, vote of thanks was given by Dr. Dhanaraj S A, principal, Nirmala College of Pharmacy expressing our gratitude and token of appreciation to the speakers as well as the participants. Afterwards, the program has been officially concluded and closed by webinar moderator Mr. Dhanish Joseph, Head, Dept. of Pharmaceutics.

Feedback collection Further to the Q&A sessions after presentations, feedback from the participants was collected at the end of the webinar through chat boxes. For obtaining the feedbacks, the participants were asked to fill the feedback form through the link provided to them. All participants received the webinar positively and appreciated the practical examples provided by the presentations. 


A NEAR TO REAL EXPERIENCE AND DISCUSSION ON PHARMACEUTICAL INDUSTRY
